

Fisco rounds off its square range with a new 6” combination square

Fisco has extended its range of squares with the introduction of a new 6” multi purpose combination square/level/gauge (ref: 56ME). Designed with practicality in the forefront, its versatility and compactness make this combination square a really useful little tool to have in the toolbox.

Although conveniently sized for working in those awkward and/or tight little spaces so often encountered, this doesn't detract from, or limit, its multi-purpose functionality. The 56ME (Fisco's model reference), is an all in one, multi tasking tool which can be used as a try and mitre square, a marking/height/depth gauge, a plumb level, a steel rule or simply as a straight edge – ideal for trimming wooden mouldings, skirting boards and similar day-to-day jobs.

That the 56ME is a multi-purpose tool does not detract from its precision engineered construction. It has a 6” stainless steel, rustproof blade with rub-resistant permanently deep-etched graduations. The stock is precision die-cast and machined and fitted with an easy-view spirit level vial.
