### **Fisco's XP81, the new try & mitre square with a little bubble!**

Sales of Fiscos' XP80ME try and mitre square (launched Dec 05), have exceeded their initial expectations, so they have extended their range further. The new model (XP81ME), has all the features of the XP80ME and in addition, it also incorporates a useful and accurate levelling vial.

Users of the original XP80ME have been impressed by two factors – the value for money pricing and the exceptional quality of the design and construction.

The stock is made from a tough, bright ABS material which has been given thick ribbing for added rigidity & accuracy, and an integral hanging hole for easy, practical storage. The blade itself; unusual for products in this price bracket; has deep etched, black filled graduations - providing clear readings for the entire life of the product. And it is made from rust resistant stainless steel.

The major design innovation however, is the adoption of a unique stock/blade assembly system (designed and developed by Fiscos' own R&D team), which completely does away with the need for rivets. This offers a significant improvement over the typical accuracy and robustness normally expected from this type of tool.

Both of these tools can be used for many professional and DIY applications inside/outside 90° try square, 45° mitre square, plain straight edge or a 20cm/8" rule. Now with the introduction of the XP81ME, levelling accuracy, can also be added to the list of functions.
